Bharat Vikas Parishad (BVP) is a non-political service organization dedicated to social cultural renaissance and integration of our country. It is inspired and guided by the ideals and teachings of Swami Vivekananda.

President of BVP Ghatkopar branch, Mrs. Krishna Gaggar is glad to inform that under "SANSKAR PROJECT" the branch starts its first project of the year with a residential Shibir known as Sanskar Srujan Shibir which will take place from **4th May to 8th May 2016** at **Ram Ratna Vidya Mandir Boarding School**, Keshav Srishti in Uttan.

We have been organizing this shibir since 1995 and at this boarding school since 2005 where indoor and outdoor activities take place on the **sports ground spread over 2 acres of land**. Apart from the school's international facilities like well-lit and AC classrooms, state-of-the-art sports amenities, music and art provisions, the **shibir teachers are the foster parents of the boarders**. We form a family and take care of the shibiritis; the children feel at home. The school focuses on **life skill driven Sanskar** that develops a deep bond between student, teacher and the environment. It orients skills **for tomorrow and values for a lifetime**. Along with **Residential and Day Boarding**, School provides **Weekday Boarding and weekend at home with drop and pick up** facilities that are very convenient for the working parents who care for **quality and security**.

Sanskar is a combination of multiple aspects of a human being - nature, character, intellect, attitude, hopes, aspirations, emotions, expressions, physical attributes, interactions etc. Individually these are measures of a person. Therefore, a complete personality is one who is pleasant, oozes optimism and radiates hope and brightness. Our actions and reactions reflect what we think - so in order to have the right coordination in physical, mental and spiritual beings, we from Ghatkopar branch have been conducting Sanskar Srujan Shibir. We have proudly witnessed the evolvement of children over the years, as some of them have returned to us as volunteers. We have been flexible in modifying our presentation of elements of shibir without compromising the essence, in order to suit the need of changing behaviors, attitudes and habits of children every year. We oversee a strength of 80 to 150 candidates in the Shibir every year.

We are conducting this Shibir with the support of Geeta Parivaar, founded in 1986 by Industrialist Dr Sanjay Malpani of Sangamner, and under the guidance of Swami Govind Dev Giri (Acharya Kishoreji Vyas). A 5-day program is organised where activities that promote holistic development are arranged from morning 5.30am to 10 pm in the night. Children are engaged in different activities where their
